Ross, and such other persons as are now members of the said association, or shall hereafter become members thereof, under the provisions of this act and the by-laws made under the authority thereof, shall be, and they are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name of the "St. Andrew's Society of Quebec," and may by that name sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, defend and be defended, in all courts of law, and places whatsoever, and by that name they and their successors shall have perpetual succession and may have a common seal, and may break, change, alter or renew the same at pleasure, and may by any legal title acquire, hold and enjoy any estate whatever, real or personal, stocks, debentures or securities, and may alienate, lease or otherwise dispose of the same, or any part thereof from time to time, and as occasion may require, and other estate real or personal may acquire instead thereof; and all property real or personal now belonging to the association aforesaid, or held in trust for the said association, or for the use thereof, shall, after the passing of this act, become the property of the corporation hereby constituted; pro-
