Ordinations in the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America.

officiate as a Clergyman of the Church of England in this Province to any person who shall have been admitted to the order of Priest or Deacon by any Bishop of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America; and any Bishop, Priest or Deacon consecrated or ordained in the said Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America shall be qualified and eligible to hold any office or benefice whatever in the Diocese of Fredericton, in like manner as if consecrated or ordained thereto within the British Dominions, any thing in the Act of the Imperial Parliament passed in the twenty-sixth year of the reign of his late Majesty King George the third, chaptered eighty-four, to the contrary notwithstanding.

Repeal of Acts.

52. The several Acts and parts of Acts of the General Assembly of New Brunswick mentioned in the Schedule hereto annexed, are hereby repealed; provided that such repeal shall not extend to any rights acquired, or to any act, matter, or thing done, under or by virtue of the said Acts: and the same may, if in part done only, be prosecuted to completion.
