Sir,-

Referring to letter to you of the 23rd instant I beg to inform you that in addition to the new Reserve to be obtained for the Thunderchild Band of Indians, they are to have a Timber Berth from which they may obtain timber for their own use, or for sale. I shall be obliged if your Department will be good enough not to grant any Timber berths or licenses in the locality in question until what has been required for the Indians has been selected. Also will you kindly inform on what terms a timber berth may be obtained.

Referring to the proposed new reserve I have to say that the Indians are willing to pay three dollars per acre for the area required.
