

al system for older children in January. This action followed investigations by a special commission which toured eastern Canada and the United States looking into the systems of education in vogue there and as a result of its report a resolution was unanimously passed authorizing the inauguration of the system at the new year.

The board adopted the report of the commission after receiving figures which showed the great necessity for the prevocational course. Inquiries were sent to some 500 parents and pupils, blank forms asking them to fill in the vocation which the children wished to follow after leaving school. Four hundred replies were received and of these it was found that only ninety could get the necessary education in the schools, colleges or universities of Calgary. The necessity of technical education for pupils in the higher grades was thus demonstrated.

Three departments will be required for the inauguration of the pre-vocational system. The present commercial classes will be absorbed and will form the nucleus of a business course, an industrial department will be founded where the various trades will be taught as necessity arises, and a department of household art for the girls.
