### MARINE NOTES.

The French Cable ship Edouard Jeramec arrived in port from sea last night. She took bunker coal this morning, and sailed this afternoon for Halifax.

The steamer Gran arrived in port this morning from Antilla, Cuba, with a cargo of raw sugar, which she will discharge at the refinery. She is anchored in the stream.

The steamer Eastern King, which has been loading refined sugar at the refinery, was hauled into the stream this morning. She will finish tomorrow morning, and will sail for Newcastle and Hull some time tomorrow.

The steamer Bremerton was hauled into the refinery berth at noon today, to complete cargo with refined sugar for Scandinavia. She will sail tomorrow morning.

The Norwegian steamer Hallgeir, which loaded a cargo of deals at Farrisboro Road, is expected in port tomorrow morning to take on bunker coal, before proceeding on her voyage to the United Kingdom.

The steamer Regina is reported due at Quebec tomorrow afternoon.

The steamer Cassandra is reported due at Quebec from Glasgow on Sunday morning.

There is no word yet from the steamer Botne, due in port from Carif with coal. She is making an extremely long voyage.

The steamer Sigal sailed from Clyde for St. John on Wednesday.

The steamer Liv sailed from Montreal yesterday for Aalborg, with a cargo of grain. The Liv discharged coal here before proceeding to Montreal.

The steamer Canadian Aviator sailed from Montreal for Gibraltar yesterday. She will load at Mediterranean ports for Montreal.

The steamer Canadian Forester sailed from Montreal for the British West Indies yesterday.

The steamer Lord Downshire sailed from Montreal for Rotterdam yesterday.
