

Denver & Rio Grande TORONTO, March 8 .- Municipalities in Ontario have the right to give a fixed assessment to any sanatorium fixed assessment to any sanatorium within their limits, according to a bill indorsed by the municipal law commit-tee of the Legislature today. This bill was introduced by C. F. Swayze of Niagara Falls. It is provided, however, that the assent of a majority of the voters is necessary to grant such as-sessment. This bill is made retroactive to January, 1920, and is designed to protect certain municipalities which voted on such bylaws on January last. 
