wise take the usual Oath for the due execution of the office of Our Governor and Commander- Governor's in-Chief in and over Our said Island, and for the due and impartial administration of Justice. And further, that you take the Oath required to be taken by Governors of Plantations, to do their utmost that the several Laws relating to Trade and the Plantations be duly observed, which said Oaths Our Council of Our said Island, or any three or more of the Members thereof, shall, and have full power and authority, and are hereby required to tender and administer unto you; all of which being duly performed, you shall administer to each of the Members of Our said Council such of the said Oaths mentioned in the said several Acts as shall be applicable to the case of the individual Oaths to be taken by Mem-Member of Our said Council taking the same: bers of Council; And you are also to administer unto them the usual Oath for the due execution of their places and trusts respectively; all which Oaths shall also be administered by you to all such Persons as shall hereafter be appointed to be members of your said Council, before they respectively enter upon the execution of the duties of such their office.
