
BILL.

An Act to authorize the removal of the Site of Victoria College from Cobourg to Toronto.

WHEREAS it hath been represented to this Legislature that the objects and usefulness of Victoria College would be greatly promoted by the site of the said College being removed from the Town of Cobourg or its vicinity to the City of Toronto or its vicinity;—

Be it therefore enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the Board of Trustees and Visitors of the College incorporated by an Act of the Parliament of this Province passed in the Session held in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled "An Act to Incorporate the Upper Canada Academy, under the name and style of Victoria College," if at any time they shall deem it expedient, to remove the site of the said College from the Town of Cobourg or its vicinity, to the City of Toronto or its vicinity, and to establish the same at or near the said City of Toronto; and all the provisions of the above cited Act of the Parliament of this Province, shall be and remain in full force, and shall apply to the said College at or near the City of Toronto, as they have heretofore applied and do now apply to the said College at or near the Town of Cobourg.
