Duty to be paid for the same.

a like number of persons of the description herein above mentioned, that the Applicant for such
License is of good moral character and repute,
and keeps an orderly House, and for which License there shall also be paid a duty or sum of
currency, to be deposited, applied and expended as and for the purposes herein
above directed, with respect to the duty upon
Licenses for keeping a Public House; And any
person who from and after the passing of this
Act, and during the same, shall retail Ale or
Beer without having previously obtained such
License, shall for every such offence incur the
penalty of currency.

Penalty against persons so retailing ale or beer without license.

Such Persons on obtaining such licenses to enter into a bond with sureties &c.

IX. And be it-further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that every Person obtaining such License for retailing Ale or Beer, shall on obtaining such License enter into a bond with sureties, in a sum not execeding nor less than currency, before the proper officer, that he will keep an orderly House, and sell Alesor Beer pure and unmixed with any spirituous Liquors; And any person retailing Ale or Beer, who shall in contravention or evasion of this act, sell or retail any such Ale or Beer mixed with any spirituous Liquors, on being thereof convicted shall forfeit his License, and incur the penalty of currency, and be thereafter during the cessive years disqualified from obtaining a License for the like purpose.

Any Person Selling Beer mixed with spirituous liquors to incur a penalty.

Any Tavern Keeper furnishing provisions or strong liquors, to Electors during any Election, without exacting immediate payment to incur a penalty &c.

X. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that any person keeping a House of Public Entertainment, who during any election of a Member or Members to serve in the Assembly of the Province, shall furnish provisions or strong drink, to any Elector or Electors, at the expense of any Candidate or Agent for a Candidate, or at his own proper cost and charge, without requiring payment from such Elector or Electors, shall on being thereof duly convicted before any two Justices of the Peace, upon the Oath of one or more credible witnesses, pay a fine not exceeding ten pounds currency for each and every offence, and be moreover thereafter disqualified to all intents and purpoposes as a Tavern Keeper, to retail spirituous
