IX.

That if any Member have occasion to speak with another Member while the House is sitting, they shall go together below the Bar, or else the Speaker is to stop the business under discussion.

Where Members may discourse while the House is sitting.

X.

When any Members speak, they address their Speech to the rest of the Members in general.

Members, how to Address the House.

XI.

The Member who introduces the Motion or matter in debate, shall have a right to reply once, but no other Member is to speak twice to any Bill at one time of reading it, or to any proposition, unless it be to explain himself in some material point of his speech; but no new matter; and that not without leave of the House first obtained. Every Member speaks standing and uncovered
