IV. And be it further enacted, That any Ship or Veffel, or any Goods, Seizures to Wares; or Merchandize, fubject to Forfeiture under the Provisions of the made by Officer of the any Officer this Act, shall and may be feized by any Officer or Officers of the of the Cuf-Cuftoms in the faid Colonies or Plantations respectively, or by the Com- toms, &cc. mander of any of His Majesty's Ships or Vessels of War, and the same shall and may be profecuted, sued for, recovered, and divided in the same Manner and Form, and by the fame Rules and Regulations, in all respects as far as the fame are applicable, as any other Forfeiture imposed by any Act or Acts made for the Security of the Revenue or for the Regulation or Improvement thereof, or for the Regulation of Trade or Navigation, and which were in force on and immediately before the passing of this Act, may be profecuted, fued for, recovered, and divided in any Britifb Colony or Plantation in America.
