I allude particularly to
the By-law No 2 Sec: 5;
By-Law 3, Sec: 1, 2, 3 & 4;
By-Law No 4, Sec: 5, 12, 16
& 18; By-Law No 5 Sec: 6 & 8.

I may remark also
as to By-law No 3, that it
to a great extent clashes
with the legislation of
Canada of 1874, 37th Vic,
Ch: 21, ^{that the several By-laws} and should not
be confirmed in these
respects.

It appears to me,
that in cases such as the
present, it would be well
for the acting Superin-
tendent to prepare such
rules and regulations (and
