I allude particularly to the By-Law No 2 Sec: 5; By-Law 3, Sec: 1, 2, 3 & 4; By-Law No 4, Sec: 5, 12, 16 & 18; By-Law No 5, Sec: 6 & 8.

I may remark also as to By-law No 3, that it to a great extent clashes with the legislation of Canada of 1874, 37th Vic, Ch: 21, ^{that the several By-laws} and should not be confirmed in these respects.

It appears to me, that in cases such as the present, it would be well for the visiting Superintendent to prepare such rules and regulations (and they
