Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 21st ult. enclosing distribution lists since April 1876 showing an expenditure of \$601.⁰⁰ being \$1.⁰⁰ more than you received; and in reply I have to inform you.

1st. That the account is very vague (no particulars being given) and it is not supported by vouchers.

2nd There is nothing to indicate the identity of the Indians who received said grain or relief save in one or two instances when an Indian name is given.

3rd In the entry of May 16th 77 there is a discrepancy of \$5.⁰⁰ between the long and short extension.
