4th The nature and extent of the improvements made by you thereon. If the applicants bear out the statement contained in your letter in the above respects, and you find it to be the case of which I have been consulted, no fit for settlement, the cancellation may be ordered upon payment of the amount of purchase money with the annual interest; and upon proof by the applicants of the reliability and disinterested parties that the land is fit for settlement, as from the fact of the lot being in the Eastern Township they would not appear to be entitled.

I may add that the lot was cancelled by the Department in November last for successful
