War Measures Act, 1914 in operation:

government decided to use its

provisions (Aug. 23rd);

enabled government to defer session

until all hope gone.

Direct defences put in readiness -

Government have worked out details of policy for submission to Parliament if need arose;
took last minute steps to avert war.

(Prime Minister's messages);

in favour of co-operation at side of
Britain in event of Great Britain engaging in war;

Parliament to approve.

Consultations with United Kingdom in meantime, to continue;
