- Q.47 By whom are you employed?
 A.47 Messrs. Taylors, Developing and Printing, 58 West Street, Brighton.
- Q.48 What is the nature of this firms business?
 A.48 Developing and printing photographs.
- Q.49 I will show you a number of photographs which are Exhibits "Q"1 to "Q"15. Will you look at them please. Do you recognize them?
 A.49 Yes, sir.
- Q.50 What can you tell the Court about them?
 A.50 They came through in the ordinary way of business.
- Q.51 Perhaps you might tell the Court what the ordinary way of business is?
 A.51 They were signed in by a shopkeeper agent for developing.
- Q.52 Did you know who that Shopkeeper was?
 A.52 Yes, sir.
- Q.53 How did you happen to see them?
 A.53 They were handed to me by the checker after they were developed.
- Q.54 Did you do anything after you had seen them.
 A.54 Yes, I was very doubtful whether the subject matter was prohibited in the area.
- Q.55 You say you were in doubts as to the nature of the subject matter. Did you do anything about it?
 A.55 Yes, they were shown to Major Gee.
- Q.56 Did you know him?
 A.56 Yes, he is the Security Officer.
- Q.57 You showed them to him. Did you do anything else with them?
 A.57 Yes, I handed them to him.
- Q.58 I will show you a further series of developed photographs, "H"1 to "H"14. Have you ever seen them before?
 A.58 Yes, sir.
- Q.59 What can you tell the Court about them?
 A.59 They were films sent in for developing and enlargements were made.
- Q.60 Do you know where they came from?
 A.60 From a shopkeeper at Worthing.
- Q.61 One of the Boots branches?
 A.61 I cannot say by looking at them.

Defending Officer: Mr. Cox, have you ever had any dealings with the accused?
Witness: No, sir.

Defending Officer: The practice of the Boots Chemist with the developing of films is to take them in give the customer a receipt for the film and then to send the films on to you for the developing and printing?
Witness: Yes, sir.

Witness: No re-examination by the prosecutor.
