1. All merchantable timber shall be out and fully utilized. Wastage of timber shall be considered a breach of contract.

Conditions

2. The operation shall be subject to the provisions of the Indian Act and Regulations for the disposal of timber on Indian Reserves, and also to Provincial Statutes and Regulations regarding outting and removal of timber, particularly with respect to disposal of slash and debris. 3. All logs shall be stencilled or marked on the Reserve, and sealed at the booming ground. Engment of stumpage dues shall be made on receipt of Scale and Royalty Accounts through the office of the Indian Superintendent at Alert Bay, B.C.
