KAMLOOPS AGENCY - CONT'D.

- 4-11-1. Nicomen I.R. No. 8--(1)--I.R.C. Allotment dated July 13, 1878, recorded in Dominion Lands Office at New Westminster Sept. 26, 1888,--"20 inches of water from the Thompson River."
(2) Official Schedule of Indian Reserves (1913) "20 inches of water recorded from Unupkukulquatum Creek."
- (1) The total irrigable area is only 0.7 acre, there are no residents, stock or improvements on the reserve and priority is of no importance whatever. Furthermore it would be impracticable to obtain a gravity supply of water from the Thompson River for irrigation on this reserve.
- (2) There is no water available in Unupkukulquatum Creek.
- 8-11-1. Nicomen I.R. No. 14.---I.R.C. Allotment dated July 13, 1878, recorded in Dominion Lands Office at New Westminster Sept. 26, 1888,--"All the water from all the springs and other sources of water supply on the reserve".
There are no sources of water supply on the reserve and no irrigable land, improvements, residents or stock.
- 27-4-1. Cooks Ferry I.R. No. 5.---I.R.C. Allotment dated 20th July, 1878--recorded in the Dominion Lands Office at New Westminster Sept. 26, 1888--"All the water from two springs on the mountains on the South side of the valley."
Claim disallowed for the reason that the existence of the recorded sources has not been established. The water supply for this reserve is obtained from Ewaal Creek.
- 28-4-1. Cooks Ferry I.R. No. 8.---I.R.C. Allotment dated July 20, 1878, recorded in the Dominion Lands Office at New Westminster Sept. 26, 1888--"5 inches of water from the spring nearest to the reserve".
Claim disallowed for the reason that there is no water available.
- 21-3-1. Oregon Jack I.R. No. 1.---I.R.C. Allotment dated August 3, 1878, recorded in the Dominion Lands Office at New Westminster Sept. 26, 1888--"20 inches from the stream which flows through the reserve" (Venables Creek).
Claim to water from Venables Creek has been disallowed on the grounds that no use of water on this reserve has been made by the Indians and that all the water in the creek is required by holders of earlier rights.
- 29-2-1. Bonaparte I.R. No. 5.---I.R.C. Allotment dated August 10, 1878, recorded in Dominion Lands Office at New
