- Q. And what you want then is to get the land that you occupy made into a reserve for you and your brother?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Have you any brothers or sisters living on the Ulkatcho Reserve?
- A. No.
- Q. Your father, I suppose, is not living?
- A. No.
- Q. And you have no relations living on the Ulkatch Reserve?
- A. No.
- Q. Where did your father formerly belong?
- A. A long time ago he went from one place to another.
- Q. Was his headquarters with the Ulkatch Indians?
- A. Yes.
- Q. And you never lived at the Ulkatcho village?
- A. No.
- Q. How far from the Ulkatcho village do you live?
- A. About 40 or 50 miles.
- Q. And how far from your place is Pahoose's place?
- A. 30 miles.
- Q. Then he is nearer the Ulkatcho village than you are?
- A. Yes.
- Q. And you don't recognize the Chief of the Ulkatcho Band?
- A. No.
- Q. And you have no interest in the Ulkatcho Reserves?
- A. No.
- Q. Did your father live on the land that you have?
- A. No. My wife's mother lived there, but my father lived where my brother lived.
- Q. Where were you born?
- A. I was born near where my brother is and that is where my father lived.
- Q. You say your wife's mother lived where you are living?
- A. Yes.
- Q. To what Band of Indians did she belong?
- A. I don't know.
