

ABSTRACT REPORT OF W. A.

The Women's Auxiliary has held weekly meetings for sewing during the past year, besides monthly ones for reading and prayer. A small sale of work was held last May at which \$11 was cleared. Two bales of clothing have been prepared and sent, one to Rev. G. Gander, South Oliver, Algoma, the other to the Rev. Mr. Tim, Gleichen, N. W. T. The Sunday school children contributed generously to the latter and gladdened the hearts of many Indian children.

A number of poor families in this parish have also been supplied with clothing. A children's class has also been formed by some of the ladies, which meets weekly for sewing. The society hopes to hold a sale shortly. The treasurer reports the receipt and expenditure of \$41.90.
