WINNIPEG MARKET LETTER

(Office of The Grain Growers' Grain Company Limited, April 30, 1917)

From the closing price for May wheat on April 21 to the high point touched on Saturday there was an advance of 47 1/2 cents. The continued easing of future prices had been giving the council of the exchange considerable alarm for some time. While a world's shortage was no doubt a factor in the advance, there was also a local condition of strong influence. The large percentage of lower grades in the wheat crop of Canada last year has been hedge in the usual way by the various elevator interests. Difficulties of railway transportation and late opening of navigation have made it impossible to get grain out to deliver on contracts, and the preference of the allied governments have caused the future prices to advance out of proportion to the lower grades. Daily offerings have become very small, and there seemed no obstacle to a continued wild advance. The council therefore decided to make an effort to steady prices and prevent any unfair advantage being taken of the existing conditions. With this object it was announced on Saturday a board of censorship was being established whose authority would have to be secured before the execution of any trade or order. This appeared to have the intended effect of limiting trading to transactions relating to cash wheat, and the future prices declined sharply, after the sensational advance of the morning.
