New York, Sept. 4.—There is a strong undertone to this market that indicates a healthy sentiment, and were it not for the dullness a substantial upturn in prices would be likely result.

Moreover, the buying that has been done this morning has been relatively good, although the market is still decidedly professional. The impending holidays have had their effect in curtailing activity to the extent of producing practical stagnation. The strength of attention is a feature of the trading. We believe that the stock is being steadily accumulated by banking interests, and look on it as likely to increase in price within a very short time. So far as we can see, there is no artificial stimulation responsible for the strength of the stock, and this in itself is significant. The Southern Railway has been strong and active. All the general railroad list fluctuated with narrow margin. Missouri Pacific gave some evidence of weakness. The London market was very steady. Reading, common, was sold down by traders and strong.
