ANGRY WOMAN'S CRIME.

Shoots Her Husband, Her Child and Herself.

Cincinnati, May 31.—Mrs. Kate Hester, aged 32, after a quarrel with her husband, Otto, aged 42, at the supper table, shot and killed him and her 3-year-old daughter, and then put the revolver to her own head and blew out her brains. It is not known what was the cause of the quarrel. A heated argument was heard at 7 o'clock, and a few minutes later several shots were heard. After shooting both her husband and daughter Mrs. Hester locked the door and shot herself.

CONDEMNNS LIBERAL POLICY.

Mr. Borden Declares Her Immigration Work Means Quantity Rather Than Quality.

London, Ont., May 31.—(Special.)—The Conservative leader, Mr. R. B. Borden, and Mr. J. P. Whitney, M.P., dressed in an open-air meeting at Spring Bank this afternoon. Heavy rain spoiled the demonstration and the speeches were brief. Mr. Borden made a point of condemning the immigration policy of the Laurier government, declaring that it went in for quantity rather than quality.
