

PROPHESIES VICTORY OF CONSERVATIVES

Mr. O. S. Crockett, M. P., Speaks of Trend of Political Opinions in Canada and Prospects of Next Election

Interesting views on the trend of political opinions in Canada and deductions from them as to prospects in the next federal election as told by Mr. O. S. Crockett, Conservative member for York, New Brunswick, who is now visiting here, seem to indicate that the outlook for Mr. Borden's party was never brighter during the last four years. Even in the tour of the west on which Sir Wilfrid Laurier is at present engaged, Mr. Crockett, who is now visiting in touch with Conservative politicians reads an entirely different picture.

"The premier's tone, he says, 'is not what was expected from it. While a certain portion of the West may favor the cry for reciprocity with the United States, I am certain that such a policy will not be received favorably in the East. At the present time, in the spirit of imperialism is gaining so much ground in the United States, that the barriers between the two nations will be looked upon with suspicion. Many of those who were well-informed of the trend of Dominion politics believe that Sir Wilfrid Laurier is in fact leaning towards independence. His bill which passed through the last session of parliament was undoubtedly the most unpopular measure throughout the country. Had there been an election on this issue, it is morally certain that the Liberals would have been thrown from power. Then there is the enormous burden on the country consequent on the building of the Grand Trunk, which is costing over twice as much as was originally estimated. It is widely recognized that in connection with this road there has been fraudulent classification of the work.
