#### NOTE AND COMMENT

There is a telephone for every 15.2 people in Canada, according to statistics recently issued and based upon returns sent to the Government by the telephone companies. There are in Canada 1,075 phone organizations, an increase of 17 municipal, 175 stock, 129 co-operative, 32 partnership and 38 private phone companies. The capitalization of the companies is placed at \$59,847,004 an increase of \$13,570,153, the capitalization being equal to \$129.13 per phone. The cost of the phone systems is given as \$69,214,971. The gross earnings for the year were \$14,877,-278 or \$32.13 per phone.

J. H. Burnham, of Peterboro', has given notice of the following resolution: "That in the opinion of this House, it is desirable that manufactured goods and natural products coming into Canada from any other country where the rate of wages of those employed in the making or raising of the same is below that prevailing in Canada, be subjected to a tariff sufficient to preserve the standard or rate of wages of those in Canada in making or producing like goods and pro-
