J. G. Lethbridge, member of the Legislature for West Middlesex, introduced a bill in the house which has for its object the serving of jurors by registered mail instead of by personal service as at present. That the new system, if adopted, would effect a big saving is apparent from the fact that last year in Middlesex county it cost \$607.95 for mileage for personal service of 305 jurors. Figuring the cost of service by registered letter at 25 cents each for postage, etc., a clear saving of at least \$530 is shown in this one instance.

The death occurred in Sarnia General Hospital Friday of John Crockett who, on Tuesday last, was seriously injured while at work in the Imperial Oil Limited refinery. Crockett was crushed under the weight of a cylinder which slipped while he was near it, crushing both hips and badly injuring him from the waist down. 
