A REMOTE CAR STARTER FOR COLD WEATHER

Kraus Industries Ltd, a Winnipeg electronics company, has begun marketing a transmitter-equipped electronic instrument that will start a locked car without a key in the ignition, from a distance of 60 metres. From his house, office or place he is visiting, a car owner can press a button on his 'Command Start' and his car engine will start automatically. It is primarily a cold weather instrument designed to run a car for up to 12 minutes when the temperature falls, and will eliminate the need for engine heaters and interior warmers currently used throughout Canada.

URBAN TRANSIT: VANCOUVER BUYS A CANADIAN SYSTEM

By 1986, commuters of Vancouver will be riding quiet, comfortable and rapid transit trains made in Canada. The Urban Transit Authority of the province of British Columbia announced last December its decision to install in Vancouver the advanced intermediate capacity transit system (ICTS) developed by the Urban Transportation Development Corporation of Toronto. The ICTS is a computer-controlled lightweight train powered by an advanced linear induction motor system. The Vancouver project will cost \$650 million.
