SN: Refers to analysis of open literature (eg. journals and newspapers) for verification purposes, including budgetary analysis, records monitoring, and literature reviews.

- **COMPLIANCE**

SN: Refers to general discussions regarding compliance behaviour.

RT: **INTERFERENCE**

- **COMPLIANCE (COUNTRY)**

SN: Refers to discussions of a specific country's compliance with ACD agreements, and attitudes towards the issue of compliance; includes discussions of appropriate compliance/verification standards, such as what constitutes 'adequate' or 'effective' verification; also refers to discussions regarding the level of confidence a country has in its ability to evaluate the compliance of other countries.

- **COMPLIANCE HISTORY**

SN: Refers to discussion of compliance debates and issues before 1950.

- **COMPLIANCE ORGANIZATION (COUNTRY)**

SN: Refers to the bureaucratic process involved in a country's assessment of compliance.

RT: **NATIONAL AUTHORITY**

- **CONFIDENTIALITY**

SN: Refers to efforts to ensure that verification activities do not collect data on matters outside their legitimate mandate (ie. military or civilian/industrial secrets).
