- (6) Local governments and public bodies to increase efforts to streamline "social capital" in introducing systems for efficient utilization of energy and for waste recovery and recycling
 - (7) Promotion of resource recycling
- (8) Restrictions on excessively frequent model changes and reduction of number of parts; avoiding excess packaging; streamlining commodity distribution systems; develop and, disseminate low-pollution vehicles
 - (9) Develop technologies aimed at protecting the environment
- (10) Promote the "Green Aid Plan" to developing countries to help them address energy and environmental problems (see Appendix 2)
 - (11) Joint international studies of global warming
 - (12) Prepare guidelines for harmony between trade and environment
 - (13) Implement MITI international development plan "Earth 21" (see Appendix 2)
 - (14) Expand bilateral and interregional cooperation aimed at building international consensus on environmental problems
