12 hrs Prize decoration of automobiles to be judged at Park. Grand Parade to Grantham Hall headed by several Bands; departure from Town Square.

1 hrs P M Pic-nic at Grantham Hall. Divers attractions, races, dances.

2.30 hrs Speeches at Grantham Hall.

5.30 Popular supper in Cercle St-Louis' Hall.

8 hrs Open air concert given by Philharmonique Band of St-Hyacinthe and L'Harmonie de Drummondville on Town square; general illumination of the town. Fire works.

10 hrs Convention of delegates of L'Union St-Joseph of Drummondville at the Court House.

11 hrs Exhibition of historical souvenirs and antiquities.

1 hrs P M Horse and bicycle race on Ferland's race course, with bands and divers amusements.

8 hrs Grand Concert at Bijou Theatre given by Mr. Paul Dufault accompanied by Mr. Dansereau pianist and Mr. Ernest Plamondon violinist.

1 hrs. P. M. 2nd day of races on Ferland Race Course. Base Ball.

8 hrs. Concert by Sherbrooke Choral in the halls of Cercle St-Louis. The Choral will also sing at service next day.
