In the event of the city engaging a British expert, it is altogether probable that the services of Allan Hazen of New York, who is now busy preparing plans for extensions to the present plant by the slow sand method, will be discontinued. The feeling is said to exist among some of the controllers that the best plan now for the city is to pay Mr. Hazen his fees and drop all relations with him. His fee was fixed at one and one-half per cent. of the total cost of the extensions. This would be about \$18,000. Should the city call in another expert the Hazen plans may never be used.
