COLLEGE GIRL ELOPES IS NOT IN LOVE NOW

Young Woman Leaves College and Refuses to Return, But Finally Goes to Convent.

Detroit, March 20.—Albertine Sheets, the young woman who mysteriously disappeared from the fashionable Kalamazoo seminary last Saturday morning and who is the daughter of a wealthy Ligonier, Ind., man, was located in Detroit Wednesday night by Rev. John Gray of the Kalamazoo institution from which the girl escaped. William Regan, the young man in the case, was also found in this city, which is his home.

Dr. Gray was only partially successful, however. He succeeded in inducing the young people to look at the matter from his standpoint, and he admitted that it would perhaps be better for them to separate, but Dr. Gray, the stern commanding spiritual adviser and general guardian of the institution over which he presides, was forced to submit to the dictation of the young woman's gentleman friend, Mr. Regan, and consequently Miss Sheets is now in the St. Joseph's convent, in Chicago, the only place to which she would consent to go, if she had to leave Detroit.

Dr. Gray arrived at 8 o'clock and registered at the Liberty Park Hotel. He had communicated indirectly with Miss Sheets and the runaways knew that he was coming to Detroit. Dr. Gray had the address of a fashionable Windsor-street boarding house, and he went there only to discover that Miss Sheets had suddenly decamped. Then Dr. Gray, disconsolately returned to the hotel, but he had only been there a few minutes, when he received a telephone message from Regan. He was informed that if he desired he could have a talk with the young man. They met, and it was then that Dr. Gray had to consent to Regan's plans. "Are you and Miss Sheets married?" was the first question asked by the reverend gentleman.

"We are not, and we are not going to be," replied Regan. "I am merely a friend of the young woman."

Dr. Gray and Regan thereupon had a heart-to-heart conversation. "I must see Miss Sheets," said Dr. Gray.

IN COURTS OF JUSTICE. The second suit against the G.T.R., arising out of the Montreal wreck, was settled yesterday by the company agreeing to pay the widow of Gus Burkholder the sum of \$4000.

An appeal in the recent referendum election is to come before the Court of Appeal. This is the one of Robert Foster, who was given one year's imprisonment and \$400 fine for ballot stuffing.

Chief Justice Meredith dismissed the action brought by William Waterworth against the Hendrie Company for \$2000 damages. Waterworth was injured by a collision with one of Hendrie's lorries while riding a bicycle on West Queen-street on the first of August last.

J. D. McCullough brought an action against the Canada Foundry Company for \$2000 for the loss of his eye. McCullough was placing a crowbar under a heavy sledge when the other workmen allowed it to drop suddenly, causing the pointed end of the bar to strike him in the eye.

Charles Fairbanks was remanded for sentence on a charge of stealing a coat. A. Sharpe, a local fruit dealer, paid \$500 for selling apples not up to the standard marked on the package. The case against W. A. James, accused of a breach of the medical act, was adjourned till the 27th.

By the will of the late George Boxall his widow is left during her life the interest on \$2000 life insurance and \$700 a year from the rest of the estate, which amounts in all to \$20,750. Edward R. Hill left an estate of \$8400 to his son, subject to the widow's rights, according to the law. Application has been made for administration of the \$1800 estate of William W. Action.

Two Smart for Chicago.
