LEAGUE WILL FIGHT TO SAVE TOBACCO

"Liberty" Organization Plans Opposition for W. C. T. U.

Windsor, Nov. 10.—Reorganization of the Canadian Citizens' Liberty League to fight the Women's Christian Temperance Union and other such organizations in their campaign against the use of tobacco is contemplated, according to officers of the Windsor and district branch of the league.

Word received from Toronto that the temperance union is secretly organizing to induce the farmers' government to either enact legislation prohibiting the growth and sale of tobacco, or authorize a referendum on the question, has caused the league officers said, to prepare to put its organization on a permanent basis.

Roy J. Tappin, secretary of one of the Toronto branches of the league, issued a statement today, in which he declared the temperance union has "many millions dollars' worth of literature for its anti-smoking campaign."

Assistance of Essex County farmers in combating the union will be sought as a means of clearing the issue. Tobacco was grown this year in South Essex.
