SELF-DETERMINATION APPLICABLE TO U. S.

(Continued from Page 1.) emphatic majority, "We want independence and an Irish republic."

"Self-determination," continued the premier, "does not mean that every part of the country, which has been acting together for a hundred years, should have the right to say, 'We mean to set up a separate republic.'"

Mr. Lloyd George asserted that no one had accepted the plan of former Premier Asquith. Dealing with the suggestion of John R. Clynes (Labor) for a constituent assembly, the premier emphasized that the previous Irish convention had failed, and asked if it were likely that the assembly proposed by Mr. Clynes would be any more successful.

Mr. Lloyd George said he wanted to say to "our American friends" that Eamonn De Valera was putting forward the same claim in exactly the same language as Jefferson Davis, and that some of the men who voted for the Irish self-determination motion in the Irish parliament had ancestors who fought to the death against conceding to the southern states of America the very demands they are now supporting for Ireland.

CAN IMPROVE BILL

Substantial Majority Has Given Government a Wider Freedom.

London, April 1.--The London Times in an editorial today considers that the "very substantial" majority secured by the government on the second reading of the home rule bill gives it "wider freedom to frame and pursue in accordance with high principle a great measure of constitutional reform."
