## Question No. 2,725—Mr. Friesen:

1. In 1976, how many original motion pictures were produced by the National Film Board and, in each case (a) how many minutes long was it (b) what was the average cost?

2. In 1976, how many original motion pictures were contracted out by the National Film Board to the private sector and, in each case (a) for how long (b) what was the average cost?
