Fredericton, N. B., Nov. 7.—The local government this afternoon and evening heard the appeal of the city of Fredericton from the decision of the Board of Health refusing the city permission to empty crude sewage into the St. John river. The hearing took place in the executive chamber before a large crowd of spectators, including members of the city council and Warden Murray, and a delegation from Sunbury. C. N. Skinner, K. C., and City Clerk McCready appeared for the city, and J. D. Hazen, K. C., looked after the interests of the Sunbury people.

In some places there are sewage purification plants, but they are put in to guard against offensive odors. It has been found by careful study that a flow of four cubic feet per second to 1,000 of population will remove foul stenches from water. No city in the world that had a river of this size for the disposal of sewage had installed a filtration plant.
