Ottawa, Oct. 6-There will be no conscription in Canada, but a system o registration to distinguish slackers from workers will be adopted by the government, according to Hon Robert Rogers, acting prime minister, in a reply to the executive council of the Dominion Trades and Labor Congress, which waited upon him today and presented the resolutions passed by the recent congress in Toronto.
