New York, Aug. 9.—Cheaper bread should follow reduced cost of wheat, according to Mrs. Louis Reed, Welzmiller, Deputy Coramissioner of Public Markets. She announced that housewives of the city were organizing to protest against failure to lower the price of bread and are threatening a "baker your own" campaign unless bakers listened to their protests.

A meeting of the market committee, composed of delegates representing 500 civic organizations, will be called at an early date, Mrs. Weismiller said. Her statement pointed to the effective boycett undertaken recently in the sugar campaign, and indicated a movement in the flight to reduce the price of bread would have similar results.
