THE DOUBLE STANDARD OF MANNERS
(London Free Press.)
There is something sufficiently Shakespearean, we think, about a clever epigram sent in as one of the answers to the Home Definition Contest, which closed London's Better Homes Week, to warrant editorial comment.
The epigram in question reads: "Home: A place where you may dip your bread in the gravy."
As we recall the Shakespearean facetiousness of that definition, Lady Macbeth, during the scene of the banquet which celebrates Macbeth's coronation as King of Scotland, after the murder of King Duncan, noticing her husband's bad manners at table, caustically remarks: "To feed, were best at home. From thence, the sauce to meat is ceremony."
So much for the double standard of manners as practiced in Shakespeare's day and as still, alas, practiced by many. "To feed, were best at home." But is home actually and really the place for negligence and slothfulness in either manners or dress? Is it home, rather, and that because of its coziness and its privacy—both insidious foes of ceremony—the place of all places in which the effort should be made to preserve the amenities? Good breeding shows itself more in good manners as between the members of a family and in the seclusion of the home, than in all the punctilious and formalities to readily put on for the world of fashion.
Again, how can one hope to be unembarrassed in the presence of good breeding, if one is not oneself well bred? Emerson speaks of the "forced smile" put on in company, where the sufferer does not feel at ease—the muscles not spontaneously moved, but moved by a "slow, unspontaneous willfulness and grown tight about the face." Who, at times, has not detected that uncomfortable, embarrassed "company manner" smile? In it, who has not read family history?
"To dip one's bread in the gravy" may seem to be a little thing, a gesture so small as to be scarcely worth noting in the whirl of the day's work. And yet it has been just by
