Here's a very good recipe for eggless cookies—it will make five dozen, and I'll never miss the eggs.

Take one large cup of butter and lard, one cupful of sugar, one cupful of molasses, one-half cupful of water, one teaspoonful of ginger, one of cinnamon, one teaspoonful of cloves, one teaspoonful of soda and flour for stiff dough. Boil over the soda a little boiling water before using it. Mix the ingredients thoroughly, for if the dough is not properly mixed the cookies lose in flavor, they will not be shiny and spicy when done. These cookies should be baked thinner than sugar cookies.
