It was moved by Rev. J. B. DAVIDSON, seconded by Rev. Canon ELLEGOOD:

That F. Wolferstan Thomas, Esq., having kindly and with great self-sacrifice proffered to undertake the formation of a Special Superannuation Fund for the clergy of this diocese, this Synod hereby accepts, with warmest appreciation, his proffer, and requests the Bishop to give to him all possible official authorization, both to the city clergy and congregations as well as to the clergy and parishes of the diocese at large.—*Carried.*

Archdeacon LINDSAY moved, seconded by Rev. Canon NORMAN:

That a committee be named by the Bishop to take into consideration that part of the Bishop's charge, which refers to the adoption of the Quebec system in the payment of the missionaries.—*Carried,*

and the Executive Committee was appointed as a committee to consider the question.
