Ottawa, Dec. 27.—The total hamigration for the eight months of the fiscal year ending with November was 80 per cent, greater than for the same time last year. The number of arrivals in Canada for that period was 225,601 or 52,585 of an increase over the same time in 1906.
By ocean ports there arrived 181,784 or 56,075 of an increase ever the previous year. This represents an increase of 45 per cent.. There arrived from the United States 43,-817, a decrease of 8,490 or 7 per cent.
