AND WHEREAS, on the tenth day of May, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, the Right Honorable Sir Frederick Temple, Earl of Dufferin, Our Governor General of Carada, did reserve certain Bills passed by the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, entituled respectively, cap. 13, "An Act for "the relief of Hugh Hunter," cap. 25, "An Act for the relief of Victoria Elizabeth "Lyon," and cap. 14, "An Act for the relief of George Frothingham Johnston," for the signification of Our pleasure thereon;

And whereas the said Bills so reserved as aforesaid were laid before Us in Council, at our Court at Windsor, on the Twenty-ninth day of June, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight; and We were then and there pleased, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, in pursuance of the said Act, and in the exercise of the powers thereby reserved to Us as aforesaid, to declare Our assent to

the said Bills;

Now Know YE, by these presents that the said Bills intitled respectively, cap. 13, "An Act for the relief of Hugh Hunter," cap. 25, "An Act for the relief of Victoria "Elizabeth Lyon," and cap. 14, "An Act for the relief of George Frothingham "Johnston," have received the assent of Us in Council.

Of all which Our loving subjects, and all others whom these presents may con-

cern, are hereby required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

In Testimony Whereof, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed. Witness, Our Right Trusty and Well-Beloved Cousin and Councillor the Right Honorable Sir Frederic Temple, Earl of Dufferin, Viscount and Baron Clandeboye of Clandeboye, in the County Down, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom, Baron Dufferin and Clandeboye of Ballyleidy and Killeleagh, in the County Down, in the Peerage of Ireland, and a Baronet, Knight of Our Most Illustrious Order of St. Patrick, Knight Grand Cross of Our Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, and Knight Commander of Our Most Henorable Order of the Bath, Governor General of Canada, and Vice-Admiral of the same:

At Our Government House, in Our CITY OF OTTAWA, this NINTH day of AUGUST, in the year of Our Lord, One thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, and in the Forty-second year of Our Reign.
