BILL.

An Act to repeal certain Duties of Excise, so far as regards Upper Canada, and to vest certain powers in the Municipal Authorities of that part of the Province.

HEREAS it is expedient to repeal all Provincial Acts and parts Preamble. of Acts, imposing Duties in Upper Canada, on Licenses to sell Spirituous Liquors in any quantity or in any place, or to keep Houses of Public Entertainment, or on Licences to Hawkers and Pedlars, or on 5 keepers of Billiard Tables, or on Auctioneers, or on the sale of goods by Auction, and generally all Duties commonly called Excise Duties, except only those imposed on Distillers and the spirituous liquors distilled by them, and all enactments providing for the collection of such duties, and to vest certain po wers with regard to the matters aforesaid in 10 the Municipal authorities of Upper Canada; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,
