- Annual show. 27. The Societies shall be required to hold an Annual Show for the exhibition of Agricultural produce and Farm stock, Agricultural implements, and of articles of domestic manufacture:
- Prizes. 2. Prizes shall be granted at the Shows for the best specimens, in 20 the manner prescribed by the Board of Directors, and whereof notice shall be nosted in each parish and township of the County.
