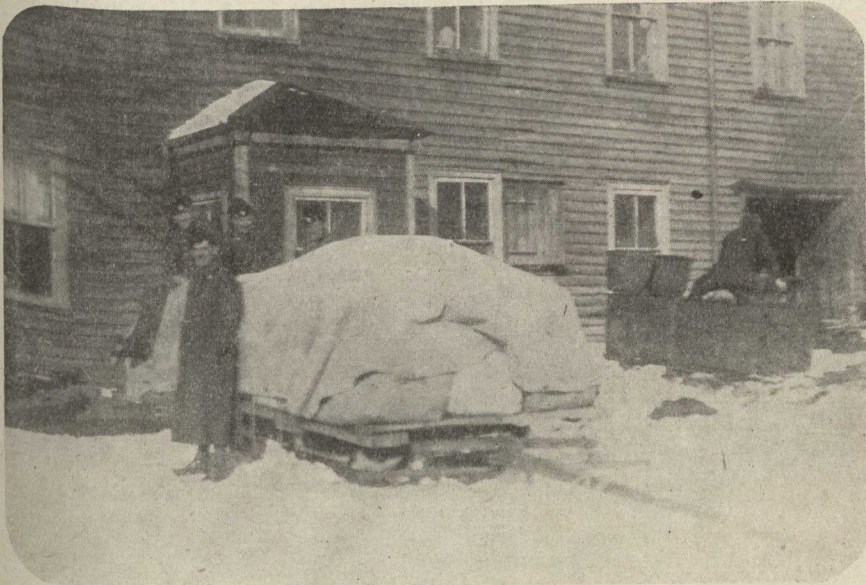


ROYAL CANADIAN HORSE ARTILLERY AT WINTER WORK
