a National Park in the region through which the Gatineau
River flows and which would be the most valuable of all
additions to the Capital and its life. All of these proposals,
I might add, are among the recommendations of the Royal Commission appointed in 1913. Without question but for the War many
of them would already have been acted upon in part.
