Referring to letter to you of the 24th ultimo, I beg to inform you that we have received a communication from our Indian Agent at Manitowaning to the effect that the water has become so low in the water-way which your Company has filled in that it is of no longer any use as a passage for boats. The Whitefish River Indian Council has also withdrawn their objection to having the said water way filled in. I have therefore to state that no further action will be taken by this Department to have the said water-way re-opened.
