



Ottawa July, 11th. 1919.

Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 28th May, I beg to say that Jean Dennis who married Germain Dupere, has the status of a white woman, consequent upon the said marriage, and therefore she is not entitled to receive relief such as is afforded to Indians. Neither this woman nor her children should be given assistance by you, as the funds at the disposal of the Department for relief can not be used for any persons other than Indians.
